REQUEST

Approve an ordinance to amend the 2025 Budget by transferring \$16.3 million dollars of General Fund Unencumbered Fund Balance to the Capital Expenditures Fund and appropriating the transferred funds for use on the Police Substation Capital Construction Project.

BACKGROUND

During the August 18, 2025 City Council Meeting, a motion was made by Council Member Ford, seconded by Council Member Dukes, to use \$16.3 million dollars of unencumbered fund balance to go towards the police substation on 104th Avenue. City Council approved this motion under a 5 (Aye) to 4 (Nay) vote.

This additional allocation will help provide additional needed cash funding to this priority project.
