

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY,  
COLORADO APPROVING A COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) is authorized under its home rule authority to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents;

WHEREAS, the City is in a region where transportation safety is a very real concern and priority;

WHEREAS, the City pursued and was awarded grant funding to complete a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan under the Federal Highway Administration’s (FHWA’s) Safe Streets for All Program;

WHEREAS, the Safety Action Plan includes data-informed recommendations to improve the safety of Commerce City’s transportation network for all users, ages, and abilities;

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a 50 percent reduction in significant injury and fatal crashes on its transportation network by 2050;

WHEREAS, the City is committed to the goal of eventually having zero significant injury and fatal crashes on its transportation network; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to reporting out its progress to the community in relation to these goals on an annual basis.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Approval of Plan.** The Safety Action Plan (“Plan”) is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2. Authorization to Negotiate.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to finalize and implement the Plan, including final pricing and payment terms, and any amendment thereto.
