Overview

- Integrated plan to maximize resources, minimize waste, and optimize service
 - Combines Streets, Parks, and Fleet
- Response begins within one hour of activation
 - Activation comes from PD or PW supervisors
- Able to respond at any time on any day

Storm Classifications

- Class 1
 - Duration: <12 hours
 - Accumulation: <4 inches
- Class 2
 - Duration: >12 hours
 - Accumulation: 4-8 inches
- Class 3
 - Duration: >24 hours
 - Accumulation: >8 inches

Streets Designations

- Priority 1 – Major arterials required to facilitate emergency response
- Priority 2 – Remaining arterials and some collectors facilitating school access
- Priority 3 – Remaining collectors, bus routes, hills
- Priority 4 – Residential streets

Streets Levels of Service

- Class 1
 - Priority 1 & 2 streets cleared fully
 - Priority 3 streets at least one treated travel lane
- Class 2
 - Priority 1 & 2 streets continually treated
 - Priority 3 streets treated after storm has subsided
- Class 3
 - Priority 1 streets maintained in passable condition
 - Priority 2 streets plowed/sanded after storm subsides
 - Priority 3 streets treated after Priority 2

Parks Designations

- Priority 1
 - Civic Center
 - MSC
 - Derby
 - Rec Centers
 - Conter Community Center

- Priority 2
 - Perimeter sidewalks
 - Parking areas
 - Paved trails

Parks Levels of Service

- Class 1
 - Priority 1 areas receive immediate attention
 - Priority 2 areas treated after
- Class 2
 - Priority 1 areas receive immediate attention
 - Priority 2 areas may receive delayed response
- Class 3
 - Priority 1 areas receive immediate attention
 - Priority 2 areas will receive delayed response
- All areas cleared within 24 hours of storm ending

Residents

- Must remove snow/ice from sidewalks within 24 hours of storm ending
- May not pile snow on hydrants, traffic signs, or public/private property not owned by them

Resident Resources

- Snow Guardians
 - Remove snow from resident's sidewalks at no charge
 - Must request before each anticipated storm

- Snow Trooper
 - Online map showing priority of streets
 - Realtime data from plows
 - snowtrooper.c3gov.com
- Snow Plan
 - Detailed information on City's snow response
 - Outlines responsibilities and standards

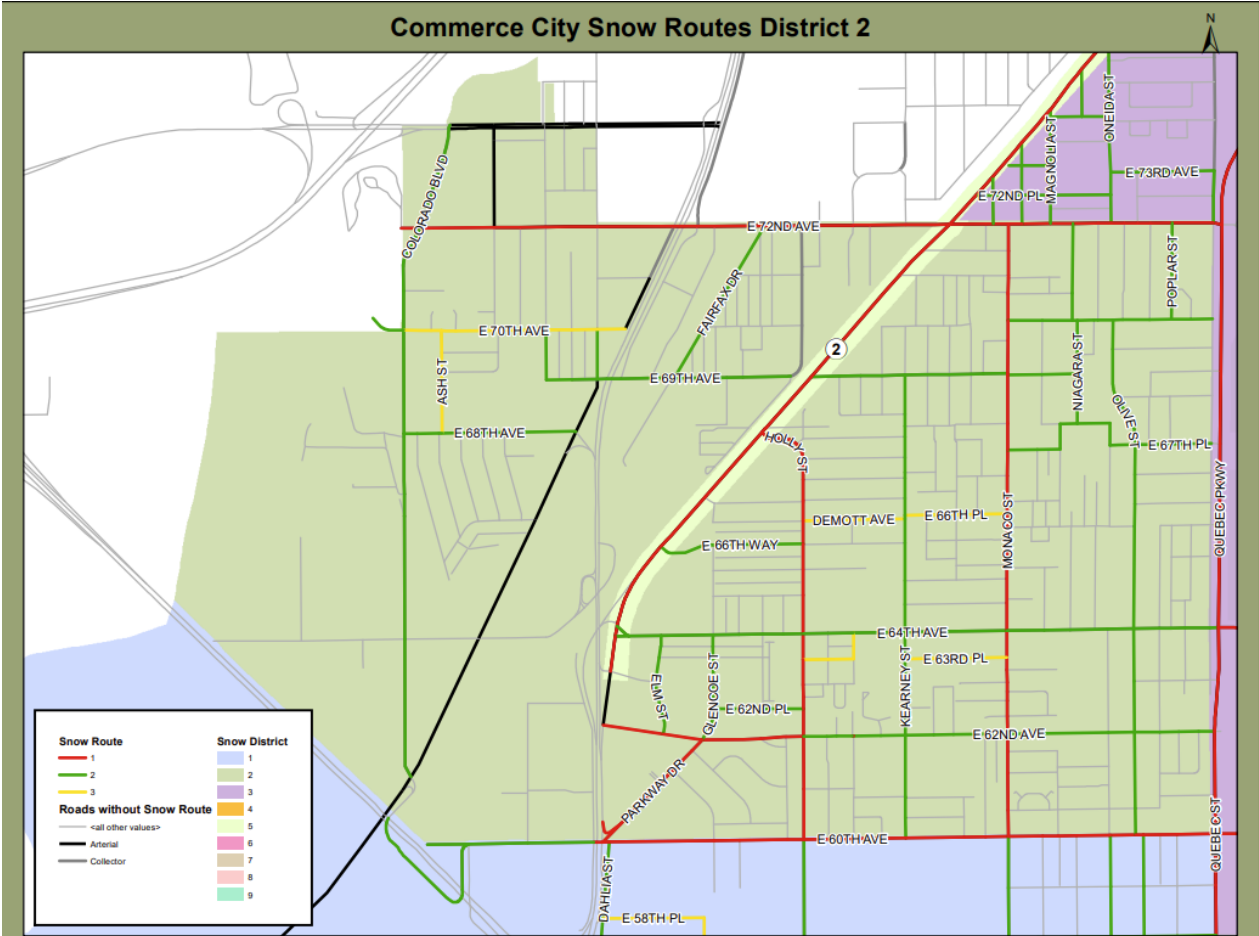
