

ORDINANCE NO. 2753

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS (DOLA) HOMELESSNESS RESOLUTION PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (“DOLA”) administers the Homelessness Resolution Program (“HRP”) to resolve homelessness by connecting individuals and families to appropriate resources with minimal barriers; increasing both the number and quality of housing resources; operating emergency shelter facilities; and providing essential social services to people living outdoors, in emergency shelters, at risk of homelessness, or in rental assistance programs;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) applied for funding to expand street outreach, specifically safe parking efforts, in Adams County (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded HRP grant funding in the amount of \$75,000 to implement the Project, which was not originally included in the 2026 adopted budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

SECTION 2. Amendment. An amendment is made to the 2026 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of funds from DOLA in the amount of \$75,000 (Fund 180).

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
