

ORDINANCE NO. 2687

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF FUNDS FROM THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,918,800 FOR HIGHWAY 2 MEDIAN UPGRADES AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Highway Safety Improvement Program (“HSIP”) provides funding for the purpose of achieving a significant reduction in fatalities and serious injuries on all public roadways; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) was awarded federal funding from the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) to be used for median improvements on State Highway 2 from E. 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to E. 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue in the City pursuant to an Intergovernmental Agreement dated June 13, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare and in public interest.

**SECTION 2. Authorization.** The 2025 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize the IGA funds totaling \$1,918,800 and to appropriate such funds in the Capital Expenditures Fund (Fund 395) for a total of \$1,918,800.

**SECTION 3. Repealer.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
