

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING FUNDING FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE BRIDGE AT TOWER ROAD AND THIRD CREEK

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) applied for Off-System Bridge Program Grant Funds in 2023 for the rehabilitation of the bridge at Tower Road and Third Creek (“Project”);

WHEREAS, in 2023, the City was awarded \$720,000 for the Project;

WHEREAS, the federal funding is administered by the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”); and

WHEREAS, the City and CDOT wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (“IGA”) regarding this funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Approval of IGA. The Intergovernmental Agreement to fund the Project CDOT is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. Execution and Attestation. Upon successful finalization of an Intergovernmental Agreement with CDOT and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement with CDOT, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the City Clerk to attest, the Intergovernmental Agreement or any amendment thereto on behalf of the City. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute other documents and agreements consistent with accomplishing the purposes of the Intergovernmental Agreement with CDOT.
