

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR
THE NOVEMBER 4, 2025 COORDINATED MAIL BALLOT ELECTION**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Approval. The Election IGA, substantially in the form attached hereto, is hereby approved. The City Clerk and Deputy City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Election IGA substantially in the form attached hereto on behalf of the City of Commerce City.

SECTION 3. Election Code. The City will utilize and be subject to the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992 while participating in this Coordinated Election and said Code will apply in lieu of the “Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965”, article 10 of title 31, C.R.S., with respect to any election, consistent with the City Charter.

SECTION 4. Designation. The City Clerk is designated as the City’s designated election official pursuant to C.R.S. § 1-1-104(8).
